Proclaiming Marrowbone Lake State Fishing Area

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70, Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 70-1-206 and 70-5-101, the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission hereby proclaims the following area as a state fishing area to be known as Marrowbone Lake State Fishing Area.

Those lands and waters located in northwestern Davidson County, north of Hwy. 12, south of Hwy. 41A, east of Hwy. 249 and west of Hwy. 41A.

The boundary line is marked with "State Fishing Area" and/or "TWRA Wetland Area" signs. A more complete description may be found on file in the Real Estate Division office of Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency in Nashville, Tennessee.

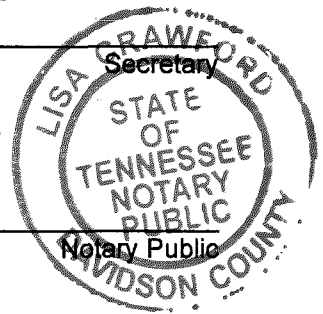
