QUALIFYING PROCEDURES FOR CANDIDATES FOR GOVERNOR OF TENNESSEE

- 1. <u>Qualifications</u>. To seek or hold the office of Tennessee Governor, a person must be at least 30 years of age, a citizen of the United States and have been a citizen of Tennessee for 7 years before the election.
- 2. **Qualifying Petition.** Candidates may obtain a nominating petition from a county election commission office or the office of the Coordinator of Elections. Petitions may be obtained no more than 90 days before the qualifying deadline date. Therefore, the first day petitions may be issued is on January 3, 2014. Each page of the petition should be signed by the candidate and an election official and may not be photocopied. Additional pages may be obtained as necessary.
- 3. <u>Voters' Signatures</u>. The nominating petition must be signed by at least twenty-five (25) voters who are registered anywhere in Tennessee. The signature of the candidate does not count towards the required twenty-five (25) signatures. Each voter who signs the petition must also supply his or her residence address as it appears on the voter registration records.
- 4. **Filing deadline.** Primary candidates must file their nominating petitions no later than NOON on April 3, 2014; candidates who intend to run as independents on the November ballot must also file their petitions by NOON on April 3, 2014.
- 5. <u>Where to File</u>. Primary and independent candidates must file their original nominating petition in the office of the State Election Commission <u>and</u> a certified duplicate in the office of the Coordinator of Elections. Both of these must be <u>received</u> by the qualifying deadline and may be mailed to:

Primary candidates must also file a certified duplicate¹ by the above qualifying deadline with the chairperson of their party's state executive committee. There are no filing fees.
