ROBERT H. BOYD died June 26, 1876. In 1866 he found peace in Jesus, and united with the M. E. Church, South, and ever after exhibited the sublime principles of our holy religion. In his protracted illness his faith was strong, his hope unshaken, and his prospects bright, and he expressed, repeatedly, his readiness to depart and be with Christ. He was a high-toned young man. His mark was set high, and his standard in morals and religion was in the highest degree. He was an obedient son, an affectionate brother, and was beloved by all who knew him. But, above all, he was a Christian of the highest type. He followed the Master not merely in the letter and form but in the spirit and power. CHAP. VI.

1 Christ continueth his sermon in the mount, speaking of alms, 5 prayer, 14 forgiving our brethren, 16 fasting, 19 where our treasure is to be laid up, 24 of serving God, and mammon: 25 exhorteth not to be careful for worldly things: 33 but to seek God's kingdom.
 TAKE heed that ye do not your alms before men, to be seen of them: otherwise ye have no reward of your Father which is in heaven.
