## MRS. URILDA BREEDLOVE SMITH.

The death of Mrs. Urilda Breedlove Smith, which occurred yesterday, after a short illness, will be deplored by a wide circle of friends and relatives in this city. Mrs. Smith had attained the patriarchal age of 85 years, and retained all her faculties undimmed up to within a few hours of her end. She was a native of this city, and was born in October, 1819. Her father, James W. Breedlove, was a man of prominence in his day, and was at one time collector of the Port of New Orleans. Her mother was a daughter of General James Winchester, who commanded the American army at the battle of the Raisin, and was one of the pioneers of the State of Tennessee. Mrs. Smith married Isaac Wightman Smith, a wealthy and prominent merchant of this city, who was at one time a member of the State Legislature and filled other important political offices. Mr. Smith died in Europe half a century ago. Mrs. Smith's subsequent life was devoted to her children. She was a woman of rarely beautiful character, cultivated and accomplished in many ways. She leaves a daughter, Mrs. John E. Rodd, and a son Mr. Breedlove Smith, of St. Louis, Mo., and several grandchildren.

The funeral will take place at 1 o'clock p.m. to-day, from the residence of her son-in-law, Mr. John E. Rodd, No. 2705 Chestnut Street. The friends of the family are expected to be present at the residence, but the interment will be private.

The ELEVATOR regrets that it is called upon this week to chronicle the death of Judge William Wilson, which occurred at Muldrow Sunday afternoon. Judge Wilson was 87 years of age at the time of his demise, and sixty of these years had been passed in the Indian Territory, not very far from where his last days were spent. Georgia, we believe, was his native State. He was a strong man in every sense of the word—clear-headed, honest and patriotic. In his earlier days he possessed no small degree of influence with his people, by whom he was always held in the highest esteem, and who will sincerely mourn his departure.

Mrs. Lelia Stapler Dead.

Mrs. Lelia Stapler, wife of James S. Stapler, died at her residence in Tablequah Saturday evening, April 16, at 10 o'clock after an illness of three days. The funeral services were conducted by Rev. W. M. Hamilton, pastor of the Presbyterian church, at the residence Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock, and the remains were interred in the city cemetery the same day at 4. Mrs. Stapler was 39 years old. She was born in New Orleans April 13th, 1859, and was the daughter of Major and Mrs. N. B. Breedlove who reside at Oogeechee. She was educated in Lynchburg, Va., and came to the Indian Territory in 1879. She taught school at Fort Gibson and afterward in the Female Seminary, and was married to James Stapler September 27, 1881. Three children have preceeded her to the great beyond. Mrs. Stapler was a member of the Presbyterian church of Tahlequah and was an active worker for the cause of christianity. She has been identified with every charitable move of the ladies of Tahlequah for many years, and was always willing and ready to lend her aid when good could be done for the poor, sick and unfortunate.
