James Roland Crow Dies In Birmingham

James Roland Crow, age 67, died February 8th at his home in Birmingham, Ala., after suffering a heart attack. Funeral services were held February 10th at Brown's Service Chapel, that city, with Rev. Frank R. Morse officiating.

Mr. Crow was the eldest son of the late Charlie and Pennina Crow, and was born in the Finney community of Dickson County. He was a graduate from Dickson Normal College, and later taught school in Tennessee and Blakely, Ga. He was married to Miss Gertrude Arnold of Dickson in 1910, later moving to Birmingham, Ala., where he became credit manager for the Drennon Department Store and R. F. Burnette Cigar Co.

Mr. Crow was a Mason and a Shriner. Survivors include his widow, two daughters, Mrs. Robert P. Stapp, Mrs. Geo. W. Collins; 2 sons, James R., Jr., and H. D. Crow; 3 grandchildren, all of Birmingham; his stepmother, Mrs. Ada Crow of Dickson; 4 brothers, Hardin Crow, Dickson, Harten, and Leonard Crow of Detroit, and George M. Crow of Birmingham, Ala.; two sisters, Mrs. Kelly Martin of Dickson, and Mrs. Hardy Baker of Old Hickory.
