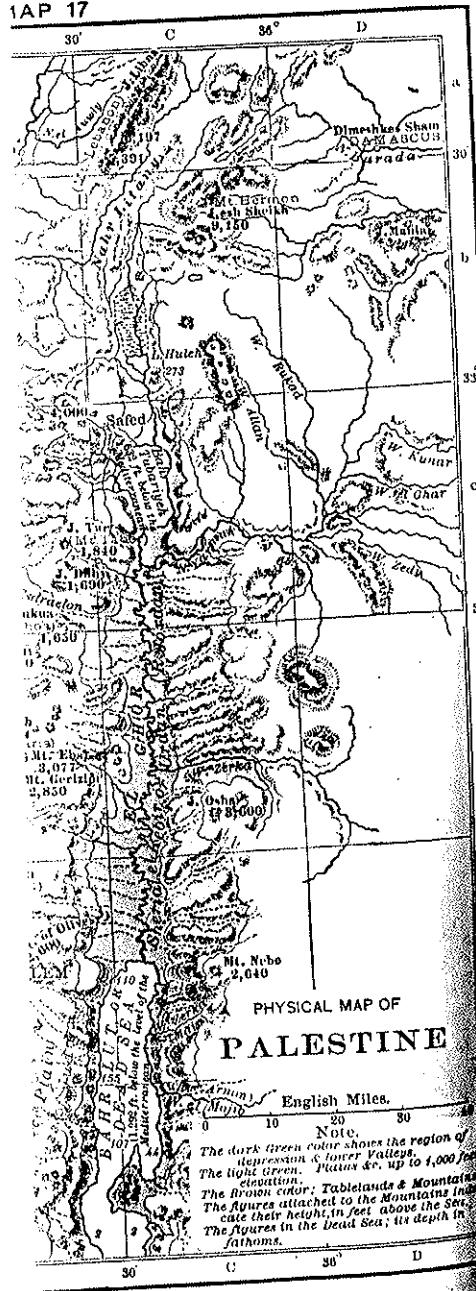

Abana (stony). Famous river of Damascus, which Naman, the leper, thought "better than all the rivers of Israel."	2 Ki.5:12
The Barada now probably represents Abana. It rises in Lebanon, flows south.	
Abarim (beyond). A mountain range east of Jordan, in Moab. Peak Pisgah on Mount Nebo, from which Moses saw the Promised Land, is highest spot.	Num.27:12 Num.33:47-48 Deut.32:49
abase (make low). Every one that is proud. Whosoever shall exalt himself.	Job 40:11 Mat.23:12
Abednego (servant of Nego). Chaldean name of Azariah, saved from fiery furnace.	Dan.3:26
Abel (weakness). The second son of Adam, murdered by his brother, Cain. His offering accepted.	Gen.4:1-16 Heb.11:4
Called the first martyr.	Mat.23:35
The traditional site of his murder and grave are near Damascus.	
Abiathar (father of abundance). Fourth high-priest in descent from Eli; only son of Ahimelech who escaped slaughter of Saul.	1 Sam.22 2 Sam.15:24
