649. Which address to Felix was the most truthful?—The simpler words of Paul, as Felix's government was "a mean, cruel and profligate one."
650. Did Paul spare the conscience of Felix?—No: he touched it till he trembled. V. 25.
651. How does the effect of Paul's reasoning upon Felix illustrate Heb. 4. 12?—It shows that the word of God is quiet and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
652. What mercenary motive influenced Felix?—The hope of a bribe from Paul to release him.
653. In what did the two governors agree in desiring to please the Jews, and so to keep them at peace. V. 27; Acts 25. 9.
