THE  
BOOK OF PSALMS.

PSALM I.

1 The happiness of the godly. 2 The un-  
happiness of the ungodly.

**B**LESSED is the man that  
walketh not in the coun-  
sel of the ungodly, nor stand-  
eth in the way of sinners, nor  
sitteth in the seat of the scorn-  
ful.

2 But his delight is in the  
law of the Lord; and in his  
law doth he meditate day and  
night.

3 And he shall be like a tree  
planted by the rivers of water,  
that bringeth forth his fruit in  
his season; his leaf also shall  
not wither; and whatsoever he  
doeth shall prosper.

4 The ungodly are not so: but  
are like the chaff which the  
wind driveth away.

5 Therefore the ungodly shall  
not stand in the judgment, nor  
sinners in the congregation of  
the righteous.

6 For the Lord knoweth the  
way of the righteous: but the  
way of the ungodly shall perish.

PSALM II.

1 The Kingdom of Christ. 10 Kings are  
convinced to accept it.

**W**HY do the heathen rage,  
and the people imagine  
a vain thing?

2 The kings of the earth set

counsel together, against the  
Lord, and against his Anointed,  
saying,

3 Let us break their bands  
asunder, and cast away their  
cords from us.

4 He that sitteth in the hea-  
vens shall laugh: the Lord shall  
have them in derision.

5 Then shall he speak unto  
them in his wrath, and vex  
them in his sore displeasure.

6 Yet have I set my King upon  
my holy hill of Zion.

7 I will declare the decree:  
the Lord hath said unto me,  
Thou art my Son; this day  
have I begotten thee.

8 Ask of me, and I shall give  
thee the heathen for thine in-  
heritance, and the uttermost  
parts of the earth for thy pos-  
session.

9 Thou shalt break them with  
a rod of iron; thou shalt dash  
them in pieces like a potter's  
vessel.

10 Be wise now therefore, O  
ye kings: be instructed, ye  
judges of the earth.

11 Serve the Lord with fear,  
and rejoice with trembling.

12 Kiss the Son, lest he be  
angry, and ye perish from the  
way, when his wrath is kindled
