Letitia Nixon Smith, widow of Richard Smith Esq. late of Huntington, Pennsylvania, died 10th July 1845. Mrs. Smith was the youngest sister of the S. Van Dyke, the father of Mrs. Nixon Van Dyke. 66. Oct. 65.

Letitia Smith Vandyke second daughter of Thomas Nixon and Eliza A. Vandyke died at Prospect Hill near Athens, W. Va. Minn. County Tennessee, the 7th day of November 1850, and lies buried by the side of her

great-uncle Letitia N. Smith in our family graveyard on Prospect Hill farm.

Thomas Nixon Vandyke fourth son of Thomas Nixon and Eliza Anne Vandyke died at Prospect Hill near Athens, W. Va. Minn. County Tennessee the 3rd day of February 1863 and lies buried by the side of his sister Letitia Smith Vandyke in our family graveyard on Prospect Hill farm. He had volunteered 4th Oct 1862 in Capt. W. Blair's Co; 63rd Regt. Tenn. Vol. Conf. 1st Army & was taken sick at Lookout Gap.

Capt. John Montgomery Van Dyke Co; A 59th Tenn. Mounted Infantry, 3rd Son of Thomas Nixon and Eliza A. Vandyke, was killed while in command of the Regt. in battle on the 2^d day of September 1864 near Darksville, Virginia the ball passing through the body and was buried at Darksville Va. by the citizens.

Major Richard Smith Van Dyke 1st Tenn. Cavalry, C.S. 2^d Son of Thomas Nixon and Eliza Vandyke, was wounded through the knee on the 24th

day of September 1864 in battle 6 miles above New Market, Virginia, went to Lynchburg, Va. where he lingered until the 14th November 1864 and died at the residence of J^{no} Wm. Murrell and was buried in his square in the Presbyterian Grave Yard.

Major Wm. D. Vandyke 1st son of J. N. & Eliza A. Vandyke died at Chattanooga Tenn. 1st August 1863 and buried in Oak Hills Cemetery of that City.
