The undersigned Physicians
practicing in the Town of Jackson
would most respectfully represent: -
That they have not kept a stock or
general supply of Medicines on hand
and that they have no supply now on
hand with which to pursue their prac-
tice; That by Adamson a Druggist of
the Town is the only dealer that can
turn his stock, file prescriptions - the
other dealers not having the drugs or
Medicines - That by Adamson from
his small stock, being a prescription
stock cannot afford to, and has not taken
out a license to sell Drugs and has
been compelled to suspend his bus-
ness, and will not therefore sell us the
Medicines or file our prescriptions at
this would be a violation of the Mil-
itary laws and orders in absence of a
license. That the undersigned cannot
elsewhere procure Medicines and the
wants of the sick imperviously de-
mand these Medicines -

In view of
these facts, briefly stated, the under-
signed most respectfully request,
that an order issue authorizing or

permitting said Adamson to file and
present his claim, without incurring the
penalty for violating the order in
this Port or District.

It is right further
to state that this application is not
made at the instance, request or
for the advantage of Mr. Adamson.
